Decision: In this connection, the Director Advanced Studies & Research has reiterated his Dissent Note submitted to Chair/Vice Chancellor well before about the SEED scholars for being time barred cases could not be processed. The Chair informed that the hardship cases of the SEED scholars were discussed in person with Director QAA, HEC based on the ground realities and background of the case. The chair also explained that SEED scholars were enrolled by KIU to strengthen the PhD faculty through interim arrangements, which was later on reviewed by HEC team on case to case basis and the way forward was proposed accordingly. Hence all such cases shall be treated under hardships faced by the scholars as the scheme was launched by KIU and the circumstances were beyond their control, hence scholars cannot be held responsible for such delays, due to observations of HEC. HEC has also proposed to place and consider such cases for relevant statutory bodies as hardship case. The house agreed to the explanation of the Chair based on his consultation with HEC.

The Director Advance Studies & Research further pointed out that as per KIU policy, the consent of previous Supervisor is required if the supervisory committee is going to be changed. In this regard, the Dean Life Sciences Dr. Khalil Ahmed briefed the house that Prof. Dr. Naqvi was her previous Supervisor and after her retirement, she did not respond any communication despite of so many emails to her.
